



Dreams and Visions

The Night of Power is one of the most significant nights of the Islamic year. (It is the 27th night of Ramadan and varies from country to country, depending on when they start Ramadan.) This is supposedly the same night of Ramadan that Mohammed first received the revelation of the Qur'an. Muslims are often encouraged to stay awake all night and pray for blessings and forgiveness. This is one moment of the year when Muslims are a bit less fatalistic and have increased confidence that God will hear and act on their behalf.

This is a testimony from the site: Mohammed grew up in a Fulani tribe in Nigeria and learned about Islam from his father. When he was about 16 years old he went to an Arabic school to study the Qur'an.

One night he had three dreams and for a further six

nights, he had similar dreams. Each time the same man in white came and helped him. In the ninth and last dream, Mohammed was sitting under a tree reading a book he could not understand. The man in white (Jesus) was sitting beside him. Jesus took the book and said, "This book comes from God, and it has his message inside of it. In this book, I will show you verses which will help you." Jesus read various scriptures to Mohammed, including John 14:6.

Afterwards Mohammed suffered greatly for his new-found faith. He was rejected by his father and several times was in danger of death.
