Another testimony from India:

My name is Akbar. A verse from the book of Isaiah means much to me. In Chapter 65:1, the Lord says “I was found by those who did not seek Me, I became manifest to those who did not ask for Me.” This word of God has been true in my life and in the lives of my whole family. My older brother, Mustapha, was walking when he heard a voice calling his name “Mustafa, I am the Lord your God.” It was a strange experience for him which had never happened before. In the following hours Mustafa found himself in a Christian meeting and came to believe in Jesus. My other family members and I rejected my brother’s conversion, but then there was a miraculous healing in our home. Mustapha prayed for a girl and cast out a demon in Jesus’ name. This got my attention, and I began reading the Bible myself. I saw Mark 16:16-18 where Jesus said, “Those who believe will cast out devils and heal the sick in my name.” I understood that God’s forgiveness is a free gift through Jesus Christ and that man cannot achieve it by good works. I believed in the Lord and slowly my other family members also believed.
